Experience the drama and history of Hakata Bay at this museum. Materials about the Mongol invasions of Japan, Nanmei Kamei, Kinin Gold Seal, rise and fall of the Chikuzen Gokaura Kaisen (a Hakata maritime group that played a vital role across Japan during the Edo period), and 139 million Japanese who struggled tremendously as they returned to Japan through Hakata Port from mainland China seventy years ago are on exhibit.
