



## **Next Generation Technology**

Kyushu University Academic City

#### Kyushu University's Ito Campus, the most advanced and largest in Japan, and Academic Research City



Aiming to create a new world-class academic and research city, Kyushu University Ito Campus, which was relocated to the western part of Fukuoka City and completed in September 2008, covers an area of 272 hectares, the largest in Japan for a single campus, and is home to approximately 20,000 faculty, staff, and students. With a focus on the fields of hydrogen energy, nano-biotechnology, social systems and ICT, and next-generation mobility, research and development functions are being integrated on and off campus, and the campus is involved in numerous demonstration experiments using cutting-edge technologies.



#### Fukuoka City Industry-Academia **Collaboration and Exchange Center (Fias)**

With the aim of creating new industries and businesses through industry-academia collaboration, the center provides rental laboratories and offices for experiments and business operations, as well as analytical equipment such as electron microscopes.



#### **Development Center for Practical Application** of Organic Photonics and Electronics (i<sup>3</sup>-opera)

We support companies in their product development and marketing efforts by utilizing our skills and our OLED device evaluation platform, which enables us to complete a series of processes, from substrate cleaning and film deposition to characterization, within the facility.



#### **High Voltage Electron Microscope**

The high-voltage electron microscope is equipped with one of the world's leading omega-type electron spectrometers and SDD-type X-ray detectors. It is located at the Kvushu University Research Center for Ultramicroscopic Analysis, which is equipped with fundamental and advanced electron microscopy

The center provides opportunities for researchers and companies outside Kyushu University to use the equipment, and plays a role as a core and center for research and education in the field of electron microscopy.


#### Demonstration experiments using cutting-edge technology



#### Flying Car

Kvushu University established the Advanced Electric Propulsion Flight Vehicle Research Center on April 1, 2019. Research on flying cars and electric aircraft

based on unique superconducting technology is attracting attention.



#### **Fuel Cell**

A fuel cell that generates electricity through a chemical reaction between hydrogen and oxygen (the photo shows the industrial fuel cell demonstration

unit installed at Kyushu University). Technology demonstrations and durability tests are conducted under a variety of operating environments.

#### **Hydrogen Energy Development**

#### International Research Center of Hydrogen Energy

Aiming to realize a big goal of the hydrogen society, it is working for the technical solution and new technology development as a management/ operational organization for whole hydrogen center at Kyushu University. It is engaged to conduct development of highly professional human resources, basic and generic research programs as well as industry-academia joint research programs in an integral manner.

#### Next-Generation Fuel Cell Research Center (NEXT - FC)

Aiming for the practical implementation of next-generation fuel cell led by "Solid Oxide Fuel Cell", the clean and effective power generating system, it is engaged to conduct industry-academia joint research program through the close relationship with development companies for conquering a variety of subjects such as securing of durability, reliability and higher efficiency.

#### International Institute for Carbon-Neutral Energy Research (I<sup>2</sup>CNER)

Selected as one of key strategic research centers in the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sport, Science and Technology's "World Premier International Research Center (WPI) initiative", it is aiming for the lowcarbon society and top-level frontline researchers at home and from around the world are working together for multi-disciplinary research

#### Hydrogen Energy Products Research and Testing Center (HyTReC)

We test the durability of all kinds of hydrogen-related products, from small parts such as valves and sensors used in a hydrogen gas environment to hydrogen storage containers for cars and hydrogen stations, and support the entry of companies into the new hydrogen energy industry through joint research and development with private companies.

#### Fukuoka City Hydrogen Leader City Project

Fukuoka City started the Hydrogen Leader City Project to promote hydrogen energy industries.

The first phase of the project included opening the world's first hydrogen station in March 2015 at the Chubu Water Treatment Center to produce hydrogen from biogas generated in the process of treating sewage sludge, supplied to fuel cell vehicles (FCVs).

\*This initiative has been adopted by the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism (MLIT) for its "Sewerage Innovative Technology Demonstration Project (commonly known as B-DASH)" in 2014.



#### Practical application of hydrogen energy

A local business firm, Fukuoka Prefecture, and Fukuoka City have introduced fuel-cell operated vehicles (FCVs). Installation of hydrogen stations at 10 locations has been decided.

## Fukuoka Center of automobile manufacturers producing the world's highest quality

Northern Kyushu is a major center of automotive industries, considered to be one of Asia's most advanced production hubs.

4 major automobile manufacturers – Nissan Motor Kyushu Co., Ltd., Toyota Motor Kyushu, Inc., Daihatsu Motor Kyushu Co., Ltd. and Nissan Shatai Kyushu Co., Ltd. – are located in Northern Kyushu. This area has grown to be a **key production hub capable of producing 1.59 million units annually**. There are brisk trading activities with Asian auto parts manufacturers, including factory inspections and commercial discussions, expanding business opportunities.


#### Transition of automobile production in Northern Kyushu



## Hakata Port – An automotive industry logistics hub

The volume of cargo exported from Hakata Port in 2018 amounts to 8.333 million tons. The combination of fully assembled vehicles (3.383 million tons) and automotive parts (0.383 million tons) accounts for a total of 3.766 million tons, or 45.2% of the total volume exported. Hakata Port is an important export port for the automotive industries.

#### **Advanced City for ITS (Intelligent Transport Systems)**

#### Nishitetsu Bus Navi

Onboard GPS units installed on regular scheduled buses are used to locate where they are on a real time basis. The system informs the bus users (via smart phones) of the latest operation status and the current bus locations.




#### Introduction of Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) system

A new bus service system – incorporating articulated buses, construction of symbolized bus stops and improved connectivity between rail and bus services – which is faster, capable of transporting more passengers on time, easy to understand and to use has introduced in fiscal 2016.



## Automobile manufacturers and automotive industry research institutes in Northern Kyushu

Within Fukuoka Prefecture, there are 576 automobile-related businesses, which accounts for approximately 47% of the automotive industry in Kyushu.



#### The 16th Asia Pacific Regional ITS Forum 2018 Fukuoka

In May 2018, the 16th Asia-Pacific ITS Forum 2018 Fukuoka was held at Fukuoka International Conference Center in Fukuoka SunPalace with 3,518 participants from 27 countries, the largest number ever. Presentations on ITS technologies and services that utilize data and IoT services were for ITS given, as well as an exhibition of the latest world-leading ITS technologies and self-driving vehicles.

#### **Fukuoka Motor Show**

Held once every 2 years like its counterpart in Tokyo, Fukuoka Motor Show attracted a record 118,533 visitors in 4 days of the show period in December 2019. Among various events to take place concurrently at the three venues – Marine Messe Fukuoka, Fukuoka Kokusai Center and Fukuoka International Congress Center – Fukuoka Motor Show has grown to such a scale that far exceeds others. By holding this event in Northern Kyushu, which is capable of producing over 1.5 million vehicles, it also provides a platform for technical engineers both at home and from abroad to network with each other.






## **Creative Industry**

#### Proud to be a uniquely creative city – Fukuoka

With IT and other information-based businesses already flourishing for a long time in the first place, Fukuoka city now demonstrates its power by applying its accumulated knowledge to the creative field of businesses, such as games, images and application development. The city administration has established a dedicated department to further promote these creative businesses, providing support that will lead to future creation and expansion of business with domestic and overseas companies.

#### Ratio of creative-related industry businesses




#### Fukuoka has a high ratio of population in their 20s who are fashion-oriented with strong purchasing power.

Fukuoka City has the highest ratio of youth (ages 15-29) population among the nation's entire ordinancedesignated cities, who are strongly interested in the areas of fashion and beauty. The core majority of entrepreneurs starting up fashion- and beauty-related businesses are young, in their 30s. Designated as a special zone for global startups, Fukuoka City expects to see a surge in new, startup businesses.







#### Startup City Fukuoka - Multi-Faceted Support Programs

Fukuoka City, which has been gaining momentum as a city for global business startups, declared itself to be Startup City Fukuoka in 2012 was selected as a Special Zone for Global Business Startup and Employment Creation in 2014, and has since established various business start-up support projects with the aim of becoming the best city for startups in Japan.







#### **Fukuoka Growth Next**

Fukuoka Growth Next is a public-private partnership facility in Fukuoka city that supports startups to create a prosperous future. The Fukuoka Startup Cafe is within the facility, as well as co-working space where aspiring entrepreneurs can work together and consult with each other about their business ventures.





#### **Engineer Café**

Engineer Cafe was born from the desire to help engineers expand the scope of their skills and more radical challenges, and was created as a public-private partnership for engineers, equipped with a co-working space and cafe.




#### Delivering Kyushu specialties to the world

#### Kyushu is a treasure house of food

The gross agricultural production of Kyushu accounts for 20% of the market share nationwide, which supports Japan as a food supply center. Furthermore, Fukuoka ranked as No. 1 in terms of amount of the sales transactions for marine products among the whole major fishing ports and approximately 300 sorts of fresh seafood are displayed in the fish markets in Fukuoka.

Statistical Yearbook of Fukuoka City Central Wholesale Market 2016



#### Fukuoka Food advancing into foreign markets

Following current trends of Japanese food in foreign countries, more companies in Fukuoka are advancing into foreign markets, mainly in Asia. Led by unique Fukuoka food culture such as Tonkotsu Ramen (noodle with a pork bone broth) and Mizutaki (chicken and vegetables cooked in a pot at the table), some wholesalers dealing with local foodstuff in Kyushu are advancing into Asian markets.




#### **Fukuoka Central Wholesale Market Fruit and Vegetable Market** (Vegefru Stadium)



The Fukuoka Central Wholesale Market Fruit and Vegetable Market (Vegefru Stadium), which opened in February 2016, supplies fresh, safe and secure produce to the Fukuoka metropolitan area and beyond. It is Japan's most advanced market, featuring "functional facility layout" to suit the type of transactions, such as mass distribution and response to retailers, "compact facility planning" for efficiency and safety of onsite distribution, and "enhanced cold chain (cold logistics)" to ensure food safety.

In cooperation with branded products from various production areas in Kyushu, we have developed a technology to preserve freshness using CA containers, which are comparable to air freight, developed the Asian market in cooperation with related organizations, and are exporting to Asia and other overseas markets, taking





#### **Constant temperature**


The majority (84.4%) of wholesalers are enclosed, temperature-controlled wholesalers, which means that refrigerated produce is maintained at a constant temperature after it arrives at the market to preserve it

## Extensive experience in organizing international conferences in the field of medicine

## Kyushu University boasts a record of hosting top-level international medical and medical conferences

In 2018, Kyushu University was second only to Kyoto University for Japanese universities hosting international conferences in the field of medicine.



#### Medical institutions in Fukuoka Prefecture and major Business Event initiatives

#### **Kyushu University Hospital**

Kyushu University is at the forefront of the most advanced medical care in Kyushu, with establishment of the pediatric emergency and critical care center which is the first among university hospitals as well as Kyushu University's Center for Advanced Medical Innovation. Lately, International Medical Relations Office was opened as a contact point for receiving foreigners seeking medical treatment.



Intelligent Operating Room Center for Advanced Medical Innovation

#### **Kurume University Hospital**

Certified as an advanced emergency medical center, Kurume University Hospital has a role as the base for air ambulance or HEMS (short for Helicopter Emergency Medical Service). It is also certified as an advanced treatment hospital, a regional cancer cooperation hospital, a designated hospital for postgraduate clinical training by the Ministry of Health, Labour & Welfare, among others, and aims to provide advanced medical care.



Kurume University Hospital

#### **Fukuoka University Hospital**

While dealing with community health care and cutting-edge medical care, Fukuoka University opened Clinical Research Support Center in July 2001 and introduced the Robot Suit HAL (short for Hybrid Assistive Limb) In 2011 to assist in rehabilitation process. It (Fukuoka University) opened Asia Robotics Research & HAL Rehabilitation Center in April 2015.

#### **Fukuoka Municipal Children's Hospital**

A new hospital was opened in fall of 2014 in Higashi Ward of Fukuoka City, providing highly advanced and specialized services in pediatric emergency medical care and perinatal medical care. For the future, it aims to become an international medical institution to receive patients from overseas and foreign doctors-in-training.

#### The 26th Japan Medical Congress

The Japanese Association of Medical Sciences (JAMS) held the 26th General Assembly of JAMS, or The Japan Medical Congress, for 3 days from April 4, 2003, at Fukuoka International Congress Center and its associated venues, where 33,000 people attended. Until then, the Japan Medical Congress, which is held once every 4 years had had its venue only in 4 cities, Tokyo, Osaka, Kyoto and Nagoya for 100 years. Fukuoka was the first to host the event outside the 4 cities already mentioned. At the General Assembly in Fukuoka, the President of Kyushu University, Yoichi Sugioka, acted as the Chairman, while professors of Kyushu University and Kurume University were elected as other officers.





#### 6th Congress of Asian College of Neuropsychopharmacology (AsCNP2019)

The conference was held for three days from October 11, 2019 at the Fukuoka International Conference Center and Fukuoka Sun Palace Hotel & Hall, and was attended by approximately 1,600 people, including approximately 600 participants from overseas. The conference brought together researchers, healthcare professionals, pharmaceutical industry representatives, and regulatory officials from across Asia to present innovative research findings and updates in a wide range of fields related to central nervous system drugs.

## The 29th Annual Meeting of the Japanese Society of Pharmaceutical Health Care and Sciences

The conference was held for three days from November 2, 2019 at the Fukuoka International Conference Center, Marine Messe Fukuoka, Fukuoka Sun Palace Hotel & Hall, and Hotel Nikko Fukuoka, and was attended by approximately 8,400 people. Under the main theme of "The Future of Medical Pharmacy for a New Era - Combining the Wisdom of Pharmacy-", discussions were held on medical pharmacy for a new era based on increasingly complex and advanced medical technologies, and international symposia, workshops, co-sponsored seminars and public lectures were held.
