Accommodation Tax

Accommodation tax will be used for expenses aimed at enhancing the appeal of tourist attractions. The City of Fukuoka will start charging an accommodation tax from April 1, 2020 for all guests staying at hotels, inns, private homes within the city.

OPayment Method -----

Please pay the lodging facility in which you are staying. * Depending on the facility, the accommodation tax may be collected separately from the accommodation fees. In this case, you may be required to pay when you arrive at the facility. Please pay using the method specified by the facility.

- * Accommodation fees are limited to the cost of the overnight stay and associated service charges and does not include meals and consumption tax. * If there are no accommodation charge, no accommodation tax will be charged.
- *The prefecture of Fukuoka will also start charging an accommodation tax from April 1, 2020. The tax rate of the prefecture, excluding Fukuoka City, is a flat sum of 200 yen regardless of the accommodation fees.
