





## Hakata people are good in making chicken dishes


On the historical side, the Kuroda family, the feudal lords at the time recommended raising chickens to commoners and lower-ranking samurai for securing financial resources. Chickens were also presented as offerings to the Tokugawa family. Another reason for Fukuoka's





large consumption of chicken was the Western sweets passed down from ""Nagasaki's Sugar Road."" These sweets demanded a large amount of eggs to make.






