# Stress-Free Connections from Asia to the World

Major Asian cities are within 2000km of Fukuoka, and there are direct flights from these cities and many others around the world. Fukuoka is the only city in East Asia where attendees at international conferences can return home the same day after a single-day conference. The convenient location means a number of important international meetings have occurred in Fukuoka, such as the historic Japan-China-South Korea Trilateral Summit held at Kyushu National Museum in 2008. It's also easy to access Europe and the Americas due to great connections to international hub airports.




Fukuoka Airport International Terminal


# Accessibility

## 2.6 million foreigners visit Fukuoka every year, and this number keeps increasing

2.6 million foreigners entered Japan through Fukuoka Airport or the Port of Hakata in 2018, up 185,000 from the previous year, smashing previous records for the 7th year in a row. The largest number of visitors come from South Korea, as well as many from Taiwan, China, Hong Kong, and Thailand.

## Compact and Stress-Free

# The airport, conference facilities, and downtown area are located within a 2.5km radius. Compact yet cosmopolitan city

Fukuoka is one of the major cities around the world that has the best access from the airport to the city center. It takes only 5 minutes from Fukuoka Airport to JR Hakata Station, the city's central station, by metro, while it takes 10 minutes from the airport to Tenjin, the center of the city. The airport, conference facilities and the downtown area are all located within a 2.5km radius, while various facilities such as shrines and temples, a seaside resort and the latest shopping facilities are concentrated in the downtown area, making Fukuoka a very attractive and delightfully compact city possessing both Japan's traditions and innovation.

The Rugby World Cup 2019 was held from September to November 2019, and Fukuoka was home to three matches.



## Business Hub Linking Kyushu's Industries with East Asia




### Growing City

#### Survey of Attitudes towards City Administration (2018)






### #1 City in Japan for Business Establishment

### Northern Kyushu Nagasaki



#### 1 Spectacular Night View

Nagasaki was selected as one of the new three top night views in the world along with Monaco and Hong Kong. Check out the view from Mt. Inasa, Mt. Nabekamura, or Kazagashira Park.



#### 2 Glover Garden

Located on the top of a hill of Minami-Yamate, Glover Garden commands a stunning view of the Port of Nagasaki and still retains the atmosphere of Nagasaki's foreign trade history.



#### 3 Gunkanjima

Hashima Island, which once thrived on the coal mining industry, has been nicknamed Battleship Island (Gunkanjima) because of its appearance. The island was added to the World Cultural Heritage list in 2015 and landing tours are popular.

Saga International Balloon Fiesta The Saga International Balloon Fiesta is one of the largest fire balloon festivals in Asia. The annual event is held mainly on the banks of the Kase River in Saga city in early November.



#### 6 Karatsu

Karatsu City has a wide range of features such as the beautiful Karatsu Castle, foods in the Genkai Sea and the nationally-known Karatsu wares. You can enjoy strolling for history at leisure.

#### 7 Kumamoto Castle

Kumamoto Castle was built by Kato Kiyomasa in 1607. Its Honmaru Goten Palace and gorgeous interior were restored in celebration of the castle's 400th anniversary.



#### 8 Aso

Aso City includes the five peaks of Mt. Aso and one of the world's largest calderas, is a Global Geopark. The changing scenery throughout the seasons make it a beautiful destination at any time of the year.



#### 9 Kurokawa Hot Springs

Each ryokan inn has its own hot spring source and therefore the hot springs differ between ryokan inns in smell, color and quality. A hot spring ticket for three different open-air baths (JPY1,200) is gaining popularity.

#### 10 Beppu Hot Springs

A modernised city and long-established hot spring resort coexist in this hot spring town. There are many types of springs and the city boasts the highest hot spring output in Japan.



#### 11 Yufuin Hot Springs

Yufuin is a hot spring resort popular throughout the country and has a wide variety of lodging. At Kinrin Lake, which is a symbol of Yufuin, visitors can see the fantastic view of the foggy lake in the morning from late autumn to winter.



#### 12 Kokonoe "Yume" Otsurihashi

Kokonoe "Yume" Otsurihashi is Japan's highest and longest suspension bridge. From the 390 metre-long, 173 metre-high bridge at a height of 777 metres above sea level, you can enjoy a stunning view. There are hot springs around the bridge to relax in.

#### 13 Takachiho Gorge

The Takachiho Gorge was created by lava pouring down from an eruption of Mt. Aso, and has steep cliffs. The Manai-no-taki falls that were chosen as one of the 100 best waterfalls in Japan are illuminated in summer, creating a fantastical view. You can enjoy a dynamic view of the falls and cliffs from a boat.



#### 14 Sakurajima Volcano

Sakurajima, the symbol of foodie paradise Kagoshima, is an active volcano that regularly releases smoke still rises and ash falls. It has three peaks and the ash-rich soil produces delicious citrus fruit (komikan) and round daikon radishes.



#### 15 Ibusuki Hot Springs

Ibusuki is known for its steaming-hot sand bath, or sunamushi onsen, where you lie on a beach that seeps with hot spring water and are buried in the sand comfortably. The bath is believed to have better effects than regular hot springs, and is popular among women because the bath is said to prevent inflammation.
