

"TEA KABUKI": TASTE-ANDGUESS CULTURAL TEA EXPERIENCE

Japanese tea has a long and diverse history behind it, with many regions across the country having unique customs associated with tea. Fukuoka is one of Japan's largest producers of green tea, like the famous Yame tea, and part of that culture is their traditional game of Tea Kabuki.

Tea Kabuki was introduced to Japan



hundreds of years ago, and started off as a sophisticated game for the aristocracy. Once you've played, you'll understand why it was popular among the higher classes, as it requires a sensitive palette. In the game, players must taste a tea and try to guess its flavor by matching it to a corresponding picture card.

The game uses Fukuoka's specialty Yame Tea, and is hosted by popular Fukuokan tea expert Shoko Takenaka. This experience is a great way to get to know Japanese tea, and find out who has good attention to detail when it comes to different tastes.



DASHI-MAKING PERFORMANCE AND EXTRAVAGANT SLOW FOOD AT KAYANOYA

Experience Fukuoka's unique culinary flavors in a historical setting surrounded by nature. This program invites you to taste a luxurious Japanese course meal at the 130-year-old restaurant Kayanoya, and learn how the food

is made with their exclusive dashimaking performance.

Dashi, the heart and soul of Japanese cooking, is a light stock that brings out the umami taste in washoku, Japan's famed traditional cuisine. Observe how it's made from scratch at Kayanoya, then enjoy a gorgeously displayed full course meal cooked to perfection with dashi and various seasonal ingredients. It is fascinating to watch dashi stock being made in this classic building representing decades of Fukuoka's culture.

After enjoying your meal, head to the nearby shop and buy as much dashi as your heart desires. You'll find plenty of choices, including vegan and vegetarian stocks.

OKAWA KUMIKO: TRADITIONAL WOODCRAFT WORKSHOP





From intricate hemp leaves to cherry blossom petals, "Kumiko" is the traditional Japanese art of assembling geometric wood patterns without using nails. "Okawa Kumiko" is the name given to Kumiko that has been made in the city of Okawa in Fukuoka Prefecture, using specific local techniques that have been passed down for over 300 years.

In this workshop, you will be guided by a member of the renowned woodworking Nitahara family. The family owns the Kumiko factory Nitahara Tategu, and has been in the industry for over 70 years. They will walk you through the history and tradition of Okawa Kumiko, and offer an insight into how this traditional craft can be used in modern-day interior design, from folding screens and sliding doors to aesthetic light fixtures and modern furniture.

Different patterns have different meanings in Kumiko, so participants



can choose a shape before being given an Okawa Kumiko kit to craft their own Kumiko coaster. The workshop offers a good insight into local crafts and traditions in a peaceful and meditative process of connecting the pieces together. Participants also leave with their own meaningful souvenir from the area.

RECONNECT WITH YOUR AMBITIOUS SELF AT FUKUOKA TOY MUSEUM





Filled with 8,000 toys and a warm atmosphere, the Fukuoka Toy Museum was built by local craftsmen using Fukuoka wood and is a fascinating place to unleash every child and adult's creative potential.

The program begins with a bare-foot facility tour to experience the wood with all senses. Then it leads into a competitive team-building challenge: strategically stack up "tsumiki" wooden blocks as high as possible to win the best team award. Is your team in it to win it? This challenge's playful nature will make your team joke and laugh, and all the joys of childhood will come rushing back — along with discoveries about your team's unleashed potential.

The final challenge will involve the teams participating in a creative wooden coaster workshop featuring the delicate "Okawa Kumiko" Fukuoka traditional handicraft. The program also includes a group donation, which will be allocated to various



sustainable purposes, including museum maintenance and support for welfare and cultural activities. As a token of appreciation, groups will have their name engraved on a wooden block, which will be displayed at the museum.

ARTBAR FUKUOKA: CREATIVE PAINTING AND LOCAL SAKE EXPERIENCE



ArtBar Fukuoka is a lively interactive program that lets you explore the diverse personality of Fukuoka and your team through traditional art and delicious local sake. In this workshop, you join session of "suibokuga," a classic Japanese art style, sometimes called "ink wash painting" in English.

In the session, you'll be guided by experienced instructors and use ink to recreate an iconic scene from the Choju-jinbutsu-giga, a famous set of four scrolls depicting animals and humans frolicking together. The scrolls are thought to have been created in the 12th century and are often credited as the oldest Japanese manga.

The workshop uses traditional Fukuoka washi paper, and participants will be treated to locally produced sake to get their creative juices flowing. From start to finish, the experience is full of Fukuoka character and offers several ways to learn about and support the production of local crafts and goods.

WAGASHI MAKING: HAKATA FOOD WORKSHOP

A delicious snack beautifully crafted to display the changes of seasons and the elegance of tradition, "wagashi" is the intricate process of Japanese confectionery making. Though varied in shape, color, and taste, wagashi are typically made of mochi rice and sweet bean paste and are served with green tea.

One of Fukuoka's longest-running Hakata-style confectionery makers is Ishimura Manseido. The company is best known for their bestselling "Tsurunoko," an egg-shaped marshmallow filled with yellow sweet bean paste.

In the workshop, you can make your own wagashi under the guidance of experts from Ishimura Manseido. They will guide you step-by-step through the process, from kneading the mochi dough to filling and molding it into intricate Japanese-style designs. At the end of the workshop, you can savor your wagashi creation or choose to take it back to admire it a little longer.
